Vineyards

The fruit for our 2011 Vineyard Series Tempranillo is from our Wahluke Slope and Clifton Hill vineyards in the Wahluke Slope AVA. The sparse and shallow soils of the Wahluke Slope Vineyard, combined with the older vines in this site, lead to early-ripening grapes with mature flavors, creating wines that are dark and complex. This site features a rare, stratified layering of diverse soils that were deposited by ancient floods and reworked by the winds.

Tasting Notes

Our 2011 Tempranillo bursts with rich aromas of black cherry, rose petal and a touch of leather. This wine is soft and balanced across the palate with earthy flavors complemented by plum and dried cranberry giving way to supple tannins and long, silky finish.

"Tempranillo is the dominant grape variety grown in Spain's Rioja region. The Tempranillo from our Wahluke Slope vineyards is fruit forward in style and shows the characteristic flavors of plum, cherry and strawberry with a touch of earthy minerality on the finish."
