



TASTING NOTES

A blend of Bordeaux varieties, and true to Sentinel style, this vintage is full of dark fruit like black currant, black cherry, and slight prune notes complemented by a subtle hint of tar. The mouthfeel is rich, with bold flavors of dark chocolate, pronounced espresso and mocha notes, black pepper spice, and a finishing touch of pencil lead. Pleasing dark fruits round out the palate.
