

TASTING NOTES

An initial impression of citrus, green apple, and pears quickly turns into rich, vanilla cream with aromas of bread dough and lightly toasted almonds. The wine has a subtle oak impact, with a minerality that is both bright and clean, finishing with a vibrant crispness.

Butch Milbrandt is one of the original Washington State wine pioneers. 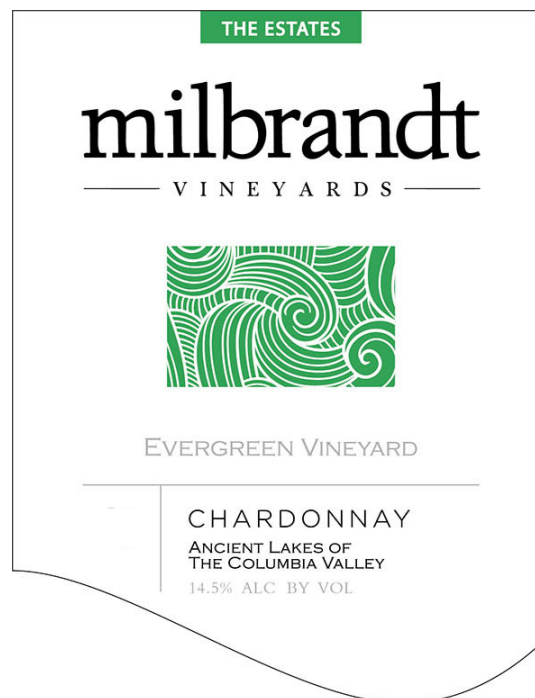

Initially apple and potato farmers, Butch and his brother Jerry put down agricultural roots in Eastern Washington long before 1997, the year they planted their first grapevines in the area now designated as the Wahluke Slope AVA. Fast forward two decades and the Milbrandt's are currently farming over ten distinct vineyard sites in the Wahluke Slope AVA and four vineyards to the north in the Ancient Lakes AVA. Now a multi-generational brand with Butch and his son Buck taking the lead, Milbrandt wines continue to deliver uncompromising quality - having earned more than sixty-five 90+ point ratings to date. Most recently, the 2015 Milbrandt Cabernet Sauvignon was awarded number 43 on Wine Spectator's Top 100 Wines of 2018, garnering a 91 point rating. A premium wine tier as well as an introductory wine tier is available nationwide.
